### **Stop Limiting Yourself - Think Big!**

Hashem's name: שַׁ-דִּי means: "מִי שֶׁאָמַר לְעוֹלְמוֹ "דַי" He who said to His world: "Dai!" [Enough!]. [*Medrash*]. "*Dai*" implies limits, boundaries, and rules; i.e. normal Tevah. "Mitzrayim" means: מֵיצַר boundary. The Yesod of "Yetzias" Mitzrayim is "crossing" the boundaries of Tevah. This is what Hashem said to Moshe: I appeared to the *Avos* as: אַ-ל שַׁ-דַי which means following the rules of *Tevah*. However, this was the past, but now comes: the [four-letter] name of Hashem, a spectacular Hanhaga of Nisei Nissim. [Ibn Ezra, Ramban, and Seforno]. With Yetzias Mitzrayim comes the birth of Klal Yisroel, and Klal Yisroel means L'maala Min HaTevah, like the birth of Yitzchok Avinu.

#### Making A Joke and Laughing at *Tevah*

Yitzchok means Tz'chok a joke. Being born to a 90-year-old mother is indeed a Tz'chok joke. וּלְמַעַן תָּסַפֶּר אֶת אֲשֶׁר So that you shall relate to your children the joke I made out of Mitzrayim means making a joke of *Mitzrayim*, i.e. laughing at *Tevah*. Right after *Moshe* protests: אַנִי עַרַל שָּׁפָתִים וּ ל I have a speech impediment, he becomes: אֱלֹהִים לְפַרְעֹה זא a God to Paroh! *Bitachon* means going *Davka L'maala Min HaTevah*. A leader needs to be a good speaker, and Davka Moshe can't speak well, and he becomes the greatest leader in the history of mankind.

The very next *Passuk* after: אַנִי עַרַל שׁפַתַּים ו ל l have a speech impediment, comes: אֱלֹהִים לְפַרְעֹה ז א you are a God to Paroh! What a joke! Indeed, Baalei Bitachon are always joking. By the way, the less qualified a person is, the more he is prone to Middas HaBitachon [he has no choice]. The "nebachs" are the **luckiest people.** In the world of truth [in Olam HaBah] they take over the show.

#### A "Nebach" Needs Hashem More **Than Others, Which Makes Him** Ahead of Everybody

The Rambam in Hilchos Mezuzah says: שֵׁאֵין דָבָר הָעוֹמֶד לְעוֹלָם וּלְעוֹלְמֵי עוֹלָמִים אֱלָא יִדִיעַת צוּר הָעוֹלָם NOTHING person forever, stays with а EXCEPT for his knowledge [i.e., closeness] to Hashem. Connecting with Hashem is all that counts, and that's all you keep in the future world. So all those nebachs should dance. If you are rich and successful. capable, brilliant, and talented;

#### The Torah Sticks Up Davka For the Underdog

Why does *Parshas Va'era* start off with mentioning the details of three families; Reuven, Shimon, and Levi? The Netziv brings down a Medrash that these three Shevotim were the leaders of Klal Yisroel in Mitzrayim. We can also suggest that these three Shevotim were cursed by Yaakov Avinu, so the Torah wants to be Machshiv specifically them to be M'chazek them.

Also, to show how suddenly *Levi* is on top! The same *Shevet* that lost their Chelek in Eretz Yisroel [Yaakov Avinu declared: אַחַלַקָם בְּיַעֲקֹב וּיחי ו מים they shall be dispersed among the Shevotim] because of their ו Chisaron in Middos, is now #1! Yetzias Mitzrayim means breaking all kinds of מיצרים boundaries, especially in Ruchaniyus!

The worst become the best, and: בָּמָקוֹם שֶׁבַּעֲלֵי תִּשׁוּבָה עוֹמִדִים אֵין צַדִיקִים אמוּרִים יָכוֹלְיון לַעֲמוֹד בּרּטת לד ב Baalei Teshuva are even GREATER than pure Tzaddikim! The: עַרַל שִּׂפֶתָיִם hopeless orator becomes the greatest leader, and those who got a K'lala from Yaakov Avinu are ı suddenly way on top of Klal Yisroel. How inspiring for all of us! Look how Hashem makes: הָתְעַלַּלְתִּי בָּמִצְרַיִם a joke out of "Mitzrayim", which can be understood that He makes a joke of all the "rules"!

Now your *Bitachon* is soaring! No more *Hispa'alus* from **any** difficulty, whether in Ruchaniyus or Gashmiyus. You learn to laugh at Tevah, and expect miracles like K'rivas Yam Suf, no matter how dark your situation. The *Rambam* says the simple *Pshat* in:אַ-הָיֶה אֲשֶׁר אֶ-הָיֶה: ו WILL BE TO A PERSON AS HE PERCEIVES ME. If he believes I can do Nissim L'maala MiDerech HaTevah, then he will get exactly what I he believes. If he believes in only *Tevah*, then Hashem will give him a life of Tevah.

watch out! You may be losing lots of the "real thing"!

It's *Gevaldig* if you're not cut out for raising a family, or holding a job, socializing normally, learning *Geshmak*, getting up in the morning, getting along with people, making a good impression, helping others, being *B'simcha*, having a nice smile, you have no children, or no *Shalom Bayis*....

You need Hashem more than others, and if you run to Him [besides (at least) trying to improve] then you are ahead of everybody! Becoming great in *Emuna* and *Bitachon* is by far #1. No matter what those foolish *Olam-HaZeh-*oriented people say, YOU are on TOP! Not all those *Mutzlachim*, whether in *Ruchaniyus* or *Gashmiyus*.

In Shamayim, you are Mamash a Gadol B'yisroel, and Klal Yisroel needs YOU. Your Yissurim are a gold mine; for yourself, and for the Klal. A person like you needs to constantly learn Mussar, i.e. keep Chazzering your superiority, until you believe it and start looking at those "fortunate" people as the true nebachs!

"Envy is Ignorance"

Many of us feel that other people are more fortunate than they are. The truth is that usually envy is ignorance. But even if others are indeed more fortunate than us, the real truth is all their successes are worthless, since the only true success is having a Kesher with Hashem. Accepting every drop of my own situation, and being Sameach B'chelko, is the true connection with Hashem.

Appreciating your own unique Nisyonos and difficulties, no matter how bitter, as tailor-made for your Shleimus and working on Sameach B'chelko, will cause only good to come out of your situation.

The more you review this *Parsha*, learn *Mussar* like *Shaar HaBitachon*, and review all your *Hashgachos* and answered *Tefilos*, the more you will believe and actually see *Yeshuos* and *Nissim* in your life.

## Novardok

I I was told that in Antwerp by the shul of R' Itzikel Pshevorsker *Zatzal* there was a *Novardoker Yid* by the name of R' Ephraim Fulgar *Zatzal*. He would come early every day to daven at the first *Minyan*. He davened very, very, slowly, and he stayed there for 4 hours, finishing *Shachris* by the time the last *Minyan* was over.

I was told that although he wasn't the most capable businessman, he made a nice *Parnasa* during the hours he worked. Spending extra time with Hashem puts you in a new world, and gives you *Si'ata D'shmaya* to get *Hatzlachos* even with less work and less capabilities.

People who live with the *Nissim* of *Mitzrayim* in their mind, have a different "reality". They are **truly** intelligent, because they live with the truth of *Emuna* and the greatness of Hashem. They are always reminding themselves of their private *Nissim*, and this causes *Bitachon* and more *Nissim* in their lives.

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Rabbi M. *Zatzal* was married to a woman who wasn't well, physically and mentally. They say that the war affected her. I was once on the telephone with her, and I saw how weird she was. She was screaming and kvetching on the phone about something that bothered her, and she didn't sound appropriate at all.

Yet, when Rabbi M. *Zatzal* (who was a *Gadol B'torah*) couldn't figure out a *Tosafos* for a week, he blamed himself, since he had complained to his wife about the gefilte fish that she made. So he made up with his wife, and right afterwards the *Tosafos* became clear to him! He didn't say "I'm married to a crazy lady and it's all her fault".

This Rabbi M. *Zatzal* once told me that there is nobody in a person's life except himself and Hashem. People are all tests to make you great, some way or another (by doing *Chesed* with them, or by being *Sovel* (tolerating) them, etc.).

When a *Novardoker* sits at his *Shabbos* table, his main goal is "not to fall into *Ka'as*", more than is singing *Zemiros* nicely and having everyone behave.
